We could start by clichés like, this ye is bigger and bett ever, more sexy al provocative, it's magical, our best festival yet!. Fortunately, we're not lying. Some clichés cloud delicious truths, and yes, we'd have to admit that all the above are just that - cliché but true!

The explosion of gueer imagemaking was more evident this year with hundreds of submissions pouring in, illustrating that queer voices are shouting to be heard. The only sensible thing to do was to expand the festival from 16 programs last year, to 24 exciting programs. Unfortunately, with such a massive selection to choose from, not all works of merit could be shown. In the end, our decisions were based on the program themes we felt needed to be explored. Ultimately, we feel choices made
lted in a festiproudly repe diversity of
our gueer communities.

Another aspect of this year's festival which we're proud to present are two media forums which will give all of us an opportunity to discuss various hot topics surrounding our queer representations in videos and films today. Among the various speakers at these forums, we are extremely excited by the festival's two guest artists: Midi Onodera and Michael Wallin. Both will also be present to premier their most recent works.

Of course, we anticipate much discussion, surrounding the screening of Chicken Hawk, the documentary about NAMBLA. Certainly, strong feelings will be expressed as to the inclusion of this work in a lesbian and gay festival. However, we feel that it is crucial that this work be seen in a queer context, allowing our community to discuss this issue amongst ourselves, instead of the film premiering in a homophobic setting which might distort the issues this documentary raises.

Finally, Out On Screen continues to support Canadian work, especially local artists. In providing childcare subsidies, more ASL interpretation this year and by making all our venues wheechair accessible, we recognize the need to make this festival accessible to all.

As part of Out On Screen's emphasis to provide opportunities for discussion between queer artists and audiences, two media forums will be held during the festival. Local and guest artists will discuss issues, strategies and concerns represented within their own work and the festival as a whole.

## FETISH, FANTASY AND FLESH

Sunday, June 4, 2 pm Video In,1965 Main Street

With Guests: Michael Wallin, Midi Onodera, etc.

Admission free. Donations towards childcare subsides encouraged.

Canadian filmmaker Midi
Onodera and San Francisco
based experimental filmmaker
Michael Wallin will be joined by
local producers in a forum on
the construction and representation of desire. The artists will
show clips of their work and
speak with the audience on
how they represent queer subjects and objects of desire.

The forum will ask both artists and audiences to consider the differences and similarities between mainstream representations of lesbian and gay bodies and desire, and representations in queer cultures. How inclusivity and diversity interact with fantasy and desire will be addressed in asking who or what, is or is not considered desirable within queer film and video.

Saturday, June 10, 2 pm Video In. 1965 Main Street

Admission free. Donations towards childcare subsides encouraged.

Spend an afternoon with gueer producers, as they tell their stories of working as out gueers in Canadian media. Filmmakers. video artists and viewers will discuss gueer identities and their relation to the nation state. Participants will speak of their experiences of working as lesbians and gavs in Canada and how they place themselves within a history of queer Canadian productions. The forum will examine how understandings of multiculturallism and cultural diversity challenge dominant lesbian, gav, and Canadian identities. Is Canada truly a post-colonial state? #### MEN'S OPENING NIGHT FEATURE

#### Peter Reed, USA, 1994, film, 90 min.

Steamy and emotionally charged, UNDER HEAT combines all the ingredients found in the family dramas of Eugene O'Neill and Tennessee Williams: ripe melodrama, healthy dollops of wit and a hint of tragedy. However, director Peter Reed updates this recipe for the gueer nineties by taking the gay subtexts and sensibilities hidden off-stage and unabashedly placing the gay content, not to mention some very hot sex, upfront and on-screen.

Starring Lee Grant, whose fans know that she can always be counted on for a great performance, UNDER HEAT centres around the return of the gay New Yorker, Dean (Eric Swanson), to his upstate home in order to tell his mother Jane (Grant) and brother Milo (Robert Kneeper) that he is HIV positive. Faced with his broth-



er's self-destructive behaviour and his mother's own health crisis, Dean delays his announcement, only to find himself joining his family in confronting each member's concerns around health, sexuality, addiction and the spectre of his father's suicide. It is this journey, no doubt helped by a hot affair with one of the locals, that helps Dean gain perspective on his own crisis.

Director Peter Reed, a dancer and filmmaker who died from as a tragedy, refusing to cast Dean as the noble hero standing against the world. Instead, Reed roots Dean in a world of people struggling to face their own deaths, thereby creating a context through which Dean can face his own fears of living. Never losing sight of the power of humour to temper the raw display of emotions, Reed is able to negotiate the complex and charged terrains he maps out in UNDER HEAT, to create a wonderfully juicy treat.



#### WOMEN'S OPENING NIGHT FEATURE Midi Onodera, Canada, 1994,

film, 85 min. Out on Screen is excited to present a sneak preview of a new lesbian feature to be introduced by director Midi Onodera. A Toronto based filmmaker, her work has screened at festivals and cinémathèques throughout Europe, Asia and North America. She has written and directed twenty short films including the critically acclaimed classic short on sexuality, TEN CENTS A DANCE (1985), which raised a storm of controversy over its combination of lesbian seduction, gay tea-room sex and straight phone sex. Her Gemini award nominee documentary THE DISPLACED VIEW (1988) is a love letter to the women in her family and a "slice of oral history" which eloquently speaks of the intern-

and a third-generation Japanese



As a body of work her films deal evocatively with issues of identity, ethnicity, gender and sexuality. Often provocative and minimal in design, her work has combined elements of entertaining experimentation with fiction and dramatic forms. Her critical essays have been published in The Very Inside, Fuse, and Fireweed. Her feature film debut is a cooperative venture which Variety has declared "stalks fresh territory." While we are unable to say more about the film, we invite you to preview this daring lesbian feature and spend an evening with the director. Midi Onodera will also be speaking at the media forum FETISH. FANTASY AND FLESH on Saturday, June 3.



# virulent images fabulous HIV

curated by Francisco Ibáñez

This program is dictated by the need to shake victim art and media representation off their complacent asses; the need to interrupt their confessional and infectious opportunistic narrative (e.g. "My Private Hell" in People Weekly, March 6, 1995); and to provoke, seduce and flirt with death. We say that "the rectum is not a grave" to no avail. HIV diagnosis is still perceived as death or the birth of a vampiric patient zero. Abnormal, disabled and sick people are to be frigid. AIDS not only kills fags dead, it kills everyone, but gay men are still greatly affected/infected by depression, quilt, secrecy and internalized stigmatization. This program is a fabulous coup to the HIV edict. SPARKY'S SHOES (1995) is the centerpiece of this program and its body and soul glory is surrounded by images of hope, self-assertion and delicious exploration.

The boundaries of love, loss and redemption are explored in a tale of how love and eroticism comfort where medicine and clinical care fail.

An assertion of the role of the erotic to resist official narratives.

#### **NO REGRET**

Marlon Riggs, USA, 1992, video, 38 min.

Five Seropositive black gay men speak of their individual confrontation with AIDS, illuminating the difficult journey black men throughout America make in coping with the personal and social devastation of the epidemic.

The visibility of lesbians and gays who are openly integrating their gueer and religious identities is growing, whether by fighting against the rejection and oppression of lesbians and gays by organized religions, or by working to revive and maintain spiritual traditions that are at times vilified and at other times appropriated and fetishized in Western cultures. The videos in this program, the majority by people of colour, provide a starting point to explore the diversity of connections between sexual and religious/spiritual identities and the various voices through which these links are being expressed.

## AMONG GOOD CHRISTIAN PEOPLES

Jacqueline Woodson/Catherine Saalfield, USA, 1991, video, 30 min.

A complex portrait of Woodson, a lesbian Jehovah's Witness, whose poetic and witty stories of growing up black and gay "among good christian peoples" reveal how she is shaped by the interactions and intersections of her various identities and experiences.

#### **WICKED RADIANCE**

Azian Nurudin, USA, 1992, video, 5 min.

Structured around the "Wayang Kulit" Malaysian shadow puppet theatre's characteristic interplay of dark and light, this Fisher Price PXL video presents the connections between Nurudin's lesbian S/M sexuality and her Muslim heritage.

#### TWO SPIRIT PEOPLE: LESBIANS & GAYS

Lori Levy & Michael Beauchemin, USA, 1991, video, 26 min.

Interviews with Two-Spirit indigenous peoples reveal the ways in which gays and lesbians from various First Nations cultures are reclaiming native spiritual traditions and ideas about gender and sexuality which have been distorted or erased by colonialism.

Lesbian desire set against the backdrop of a South Asian Muslim wedding.

#### **BODY OF DISSENT**

Cate Friesen, Greg Lichti, Holly Nattall, Gordon Bowness, Canada, 1994, video, 39 min.

This tape is the first to give voice to the struggles of lesbian and gay Mennonites and Brethren, whose rejection from these churches contradicts the social justice doctrine they were taught to believe in..

With equality rights under attack from homophobic opposition, pedophilia has emerged as a spectre used (much like AIDS or S/M) to prove the threat of sexuality and homosexuals. Without denying the extent of child sexual abuse and the enormous pain it has caused in our lives, it is important to recognize that accusations of child abuse have been targeted against gays by Reform and Liberals alike. While the majority of child abuse takes place in the heterosexual family, the homosexual man who loves boys has become a scapegoat in the homophobic imagination. Canada's newly amended child pornography laws have been used primarily to target gay men and artists, young and old, who are neither pedophiles nor sexual offenders.

To speak about questions of power and consent has become divisive even within queer communities, despite the necessity of this for both the process of healing and learning to empower and protect children. Together Chicken Hawk and Blue Boys suggest the necessity that we continue to speak about our lives, and resist the efforts of a homophobic culture which confuses child abuse with homosexuality.

A discussion will follow.



#### **BLUE BOYS**

Stuart Marshall, UK, 1992, video, 25 min.

Every year hundreds of gay men in Britain are brought to trial for owning gay porn, as media and police claim they are protecting citizens from porn and sex rings. This hard-news documentary includes interviews with those convicted in the 1990 "Spanner" trial which effectively criminalized S/M.

# CHICKEN HAWK: MEN WHO LOVE BOYS

Adi Sideman, USA, 1994, video, 55 min.

This thought-provoking documentary focuses on the lives of five NAMBLA members, documenting a wide range of opinions from man/boy lovers to their detractors, within and outside the gay community. By drawing our attention to the differences among NAMBLA members, we are reminded that however one may feel about pedophilia, this is also a question about our ability to move beyond homophobic sensationalism and vilification.

# AND, of course, SEX

A selection of new erotic video surveying the perils and pleasures of gay eros. These tapes look to sex as a place of passion, power and humour. While pointing out the ways gay sex is complicated by AIDS/HIV, racism, homophobia, and commodification, this work is first and foremost about the the steamy joys of gay sex, including such overlooked pleasures as jacking off, cruising straights and making gay subtexts explicit.



## GAY BOY: WE DO NOT GO EXTINCT

Aaron Pollard, Canada, 1994, video, 8 min.

Thoughts on living and loving in a world which would often rather see you dead.

#### RE:GENERATION

Stuart Gaffney, USA, 1995, Video, 6 min.

An exploration of how two men feel about contracting and living with HIV.



#### I LIKE DREAMING

Charles Lofton, USA, 1994, video, 7 min.

A confession on the pleasures of cruising straight men.

#### HE IS BOLD AND HE IS A RACIST, HE IS GAY AND HE IS A FASCIST

Jürgen Brüning, Germany, 1994, video, 26 min.

A raw and provocative documentary on gay skinheads in Berlin considers skins as the macho image of the 90's, while visually reminding us of the look's facsist basis. Awarded Best Gay Documentary at Berlin, 1995.



#### **VOI CHE SAPETE**

William Comstock, USA, 1993, video, 5 min.

An exquisite vision created out of rare footage discovered in a garbage dumpster, and set to Cherubino's gender-bending aria from *The Marriage of Figaro*.

David Collins & Ian Jarvis, Canada, 1994, video, 5 min.

A satire on pop culture, gay porn, and not being able to live, "if living is without you".

#### **SELF-PLEASURING**

Certainly not your standard talking head documentary, the tape does document the thoughts of a range of men on how and why they jerk off.

#### **TACKY GREEK MOVIE**

Bruno Leydet, USA, 1995 , video, 12 min.

The realization of an adolescent dream of seeing gay erotica in straight media is fulfilled as gay subtext takes over rescanned soft porn footage.

#### **BED SPACE**

Eric Rancourt, Canada, 1994, film on video, 8 min.







# BLACK SHEEP BOY

# an evening with michael wallin

San Francisco based filmmaker Michael Wallin will introduce the world premiere of BLACK SHEEP BOY, an examination of sexual fantasy and the tension between "real people" and "sexual objects". Over nearly three decades Wallin has explored desire, intimacy, and sexual relationships, while refining his talent for producing experimental work marked by its honesty and visual poignancy. One of the most exciting and talented filmmakers working today, retrospectives of his work have screened throughout the U.S., including in 1990 at the MOMA in New York. The program will include his award-winning work with found footage, DECODINGS (1988), and THE PLACE BETWEEN OUR BODIES (1975), a personal account of a search for sexual love. For those of you who have never tried the pleasures of queer experimental film, Wallin's work offers an evening of engaging and entertaining cinematic magic.



# THE PLACE BETWEEN OUR BODIES
